## Policies & Procedures



### Preschool Arrival and Pickup

9:15 ~ 12:15 M-F



School begins at 9:15 a. m. Please do not bring your child prior to this time. Although you may see other children in the school, it is likely they are children of teachers. Pickup is promptly at 12:15 p.m. for preschoolers. A late fee of \$5 per 5 minutes will be charged, payable on the spot in cash, for continued tardiness. Your child will not be released to anyone other than you unless we have a written note stating the name of the designated person; a photo I. D. of that person must be provided.

#### Snacks

A mid-morning snack of crackers is offered. All classes except for the 4 year old Pre-K classes may bring a juice cup. Water is provided for 4 year olds. Your teachers need to be aware of any allergies. When snacks are provided by parents for parties, please remember that we do not allow nuts.

#### Potty Training

Children enrolled in the 3 year old classes and older must be potty trained by the time school starts in September.

#### Safety

Drills practicing where to go in case of fire, tornados or hurricanes are practiced during school hours once a semester.



#### Speech & Language Screenings / Vision Screenings

Annual screenings will be offered by licensed personnel for a small fee. A thorough written assessment will be provided.

### Kindergarten Arrival and Pickup

9:15 ~ 12:15 MWF

9:15 ~ 2:30 T Th

One of our Kindergarten goals is to help make the transition to 1st grade a smooth one. It is important that prompt arrival be observed so that students learn the value of a timely start and begin their day calmly. School begins at 9:15 a.m. On Monday, Wednesday and Friday, pickup is at 12:15 p.m. On Tuesday and Thursday, pickup is at 2:30 p.m. A late fee of \$5 per 5 minutes will be charged, payable on the spot in cash,



for continued tardiness. Your child will not be released to anyone other than you unless we have a written note stating the name of the designated person; a photo I.D. of that person must be provided.

#### Kindergarten Snack & Lunch

Kindergartners will be offered a mid-morning snack of crackers and water. On Tuesday and Thursday, Kindergarteners will bring a lunch and a drink from home. Please inform teachers of allergies. Lunch may not be shared among students. When parents provide party snacks, please remember that we do not allow nuts.

#### Lunch Bunch

Our 3 and 4 year olds are invited to stay on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for lunch with their friends until 1:15 p. m. Kindergartners may stay on Wednesdays. Sign up is posted Monday through Wednesday. Lunch Bunch is \$6; parents purchase lunch tickets which serve as a reservation for their child. Children bring their own lunch and, weather permitting, go outside as part of their extra hour at school.



## Policies & Procedures



### Discipline

St. Luke's Little Saints follows The Golden Rule. Our teachers gently correct inappropriate behavior by teaching better choices, utilizing positive reinforcement of good behavior and by redirection. If necessary, time out will be used 1 minute per age of child. Biting is not tolerated; parents will be notified and child will be sent home for the day.

### Wellness Policy



Our staff will make every effort to help keep your child well. Your child will not enjoy the Program if he or she is not feeling well. To ensure that children stay healthy while they are enrolled, please do not bring your child to school if he or she shows any of the following symptoms in the 24 hours prior to class: fever; runny nose with colored discharge; rash; diarrhea; vomiting; unexplained itchy scalp. If our teachers notice any of these symptoms or any abnormal changes in behavior, you will be notified.

### Medications

Staff members may not administer any medications to any child. If a child needs medication, a parent must come to school to administer same.

### Emergency Procedures

In case of illness or accident the school will attempt to contact a parent for direction as to treatment. In the event we cannot reach a parent, or where judgment dictates it would be detrimental to your child to delay treatment, we will call 911 and your child will be taken to Children's Healthcare of Atlanta at Scottish Rite via emergency vehicle. The signed Authorization Form, filled out in the Summer Packet, will be sent with your child.

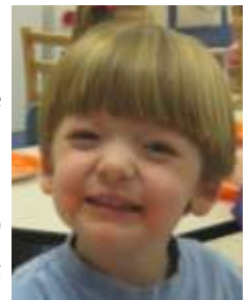


### Scholarship Fund

Presbyterian Women, an organization within St. Luke's Presbyterian Church, donates a partial scholarship designated for SLLS families who are undergoing financial hardship. Interested families should contact the Director for further information.

### Refunds/Withdrawal

No refunds will be made. A thirty day notice is appreciated for withdrawal from SLLS. No refund for withdrawal will be made. No refunds will be made for short or long absences. With extended absence or illness, monthly tuition must be paid to reserve your child's place in the class.



### Incident Weather Policy

Emergency closing of school due to storms, snow, etc. will follow the same procedure as DeKalb County Schools. Announcements are broadcast from local radio stations at the time of the emergency. If DeKalb County Schools are closed or delayed for weather emergencies, SLLS is closed.

### Emergency Cards

Two emergency notification cards must be filled out and signed by a parent and filed in our office on or before the first day of school. One card remains in the Director's office and the second is kept in the classroom. The Director should be notified of any updates.

### Child Abuse

St. Luke's Little Saints is required by law to report any suspected child abuse, neglect, exploitation, or deprivation to the Department of Family and Children's Services.

### Tuition

Tuition fees are paid on a monthly basis. With the exception of September, tuition is due one month prior to services. Therefore, October tuition is due September 1st; November tuition is due October 1st; and so on. September tuition is due in May.

A late fee of \$10 per student will be charged for tuition received after the 7th of the month. In other words, families have seven days to pay tuition in a timely manner.
